Domaine Houchart is one of few remaining estate-bottled Provence Reds, known for its bursting red berry and pepper aromas. Situated at the foot of Mount St. Victoire near Aix en Provence, its sun-soaked terroir and vineyards sheltered from powerful Mistral winds set the stage for first-class winemaking. Rejuvenated in 1890 when purchased by Aurelien Houchart, the estate was later named after him by his great-great granddaughter, Genevieve Quiot. Today, Domaine Houchart is owned and run by Genevieve's children, Florence and Jean-Baptiste Quiot. With consistent quality, the Quiot family brings versatile, well-rated, food-friendly wines.
