Established as a winemaking property in 1790, Château L'Orangerie has maintained a rich winemaking tradition through ten generations of the Icard family. Named after a family tradition of conserving orange trees in a wing of the château during winter months, today Château L'Orangerie sustainably farms 250 acres of vineyards – still surrounded by orange trees. Sitting in the heart of Entre-Deux-Mers, Bordeaux's largest appellation, the vineyards are uniquely situated on a clay-limestone terroir to produce the perfect Cabernet Sauvignon grape that is turned into this brilliant, silky single vineyard delight.

Vinification: Grapes are harvested at full ripeness for full potential. Thermo-vinified to preserve the intensity, color and aromas. Aging continues in concrete vats, preserving the freshness & fruitiness

Tasting Notes: Deep, intense purplish-red. The nose is open, bewitching and highly aromatic, with notes of violet, blackcurrant and ripe fruit. A well-balanced wine structured by rich tannins and a charming, persistent, delicately fruity finish.
